## **GVPOA SCHOLARSHIP**

- 1. Suggest that the GVPOA approve the awarding of an annual scholarship to high school students from counties that make up the territory served by the GVPOA.
  - a. Can be awarded to one student in the amount of \$500, or**
  - b. Can be awarded in the amount of \$300 to two students (\$600)****
- 2. The recipient(s) must have selected and been accepted to a college or university accredited by the Southern Association (SACS)**
- 3. The recipient(s) must submit an application form (to be established by members of a standing committee to be appointed by the board of directors) to the Board. On a date determined, the Board will call for applications and establish a deadline for submission. The Board will meet as frequently as necessary to determine recipient(s).**
- 4. The Scholarship will be presented to the recipient at the July general membership meeting each year (or other date as determined by the Board upon recommendation of the reviewers).**
- 5. Applier of the application must be: (select one or more)
  - a. From a community where GVPOA has representation (membership)**
  - b. The child of an active GVPOA member (in good standing)**
  - c. The surviving child (or grandchild) of a deceased former GVPOA member of good standing**
  - d. The surviving child of any peace officer killed in LOD****
- 6. The application shall be available from and returned upon completion to the secretary of the GVPOA at each scholarship cycle.**

**7. The application shall include a minimum of 500-word essay as to their deservability of the scholarship.**

**8. Applicants may apply each year until they complete an undergraduate degree, however once awarded a scholarship, the applicant is no longer eligible to apply.**

**NOTE: The Scholarship Program has 2 sets of Options to be Considered.**
