The meeting of the Guadalupe Valley Peace Officers Association was called to order by President Ron Eberhardt. The Invocation was given by Bob Christy.

The meeting was held at the Power Plant in Seguin. The meeting was hosted by the Chief Ron Eberhardt and Garden Ridge Police Department.

Guests and new members were introduced. There were 19 in attendance.

The minutes of the January 18, 2018 meeting, printed on the back of the meeting notice, were approved.

The financial report was read by the Secretary-Treasurer and was approved.

Ron Eberhardt introduced the guest speakers for the evening, Christy Williams of the Children's Advocacy Center of Guadalupe County and Trendy Sharp of the Children's Advocacy Center of Comal County.

OLD BUSINESS: The GVPOA Scholarship Program was opened. There was a brief discussion on naming the scholarship after Jerry Smith if approved. Gary Haecker made a motion to use no funds from the existing GVPOA accounts for the Scholarship Program, seconded by Bob Christy. With a spilt vote, Motion passed. Gary Haecker made a motion to generate funds by other methods to fund the Scholarship Program, seconded by Mike Harris. Motion passed. GVPOA is not presently a 501(c) 3 non-profit. Mike Harris made a motion to submit paperwork for 501 (c) 3 non-profit status, seconded by Bob Christy. Motion Approved. Discussion: The creation of a Scholarship Program is on hold until a 501 (c) 3 is approved and fundraising program is in place.

NEW BUSINESS: Only new business was to fill 2nd & 3rd Vice President vacancies. Gary Haecker nominated Larry Rakoski for 2nd Vice President and he was elected. Buddy Lovestock nominated Ron Eberhardt for 3rd Vice President and he was elected.
