The meeting of the Guadalupe Valley Peace Officers Association was called to order by President Mike Harris. The meeting was held at Rudy's BarBeQue in New Braunfels, hosted by George Green.

The Invocation was given by Joe Hamilton.  
The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Guests and new members were introduced. There were 19 in attendance.

The minutes of the January 16, 2020 meeting, printed on the back of the meeting notice were approved.

The financial report was read by the Secretary-Treasurer and approved.

Mike Harris presented Reno Reiley a Plaque for the years of service as Secretary-Treasurer for GVPOA.

Meeting was turned over to Ron Eberhardt, 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President.

Reno Reiley was nominated for Secretary-Treasurer, by Joe, Mike moved nomination cease, seconded and approved. Will be looking for a Secretary-Treasurer to run in January 2022.
